REFUND POLICY: Any notification of withdrawal or cancellation and request for refund must be in writing. A withdrawal form must be completed and all necessary signatures obtained. Upon receipt of written notification of cancellation, one hundred percent (100%) of the tuition charged will be refunded if made within seventy-two (72) hours of the signing of this registration agreement. If after the expiration of the 72 hour cancellation period, the student does not enter this course, one hundred dollars (\$100.00) will be retained by Kent County School of Real Estate. After student enters this course, the school will retain \$100.00 and the following percentages will be returned to the student less the \$100.00: during the first week of class a refund of 90% will be issued; during the second week a refund of 80% will be issued; during the third week a refund of 75% will be issued; during the fourth week a refund of 60% will be issued; in the fifth week 50% will be issued and after this there will be no refund issued. After the first week, there will be no refunds on text books. Also, there will be no refund of any text book that has been written in, subjects highlighted or shows wear and tear.
